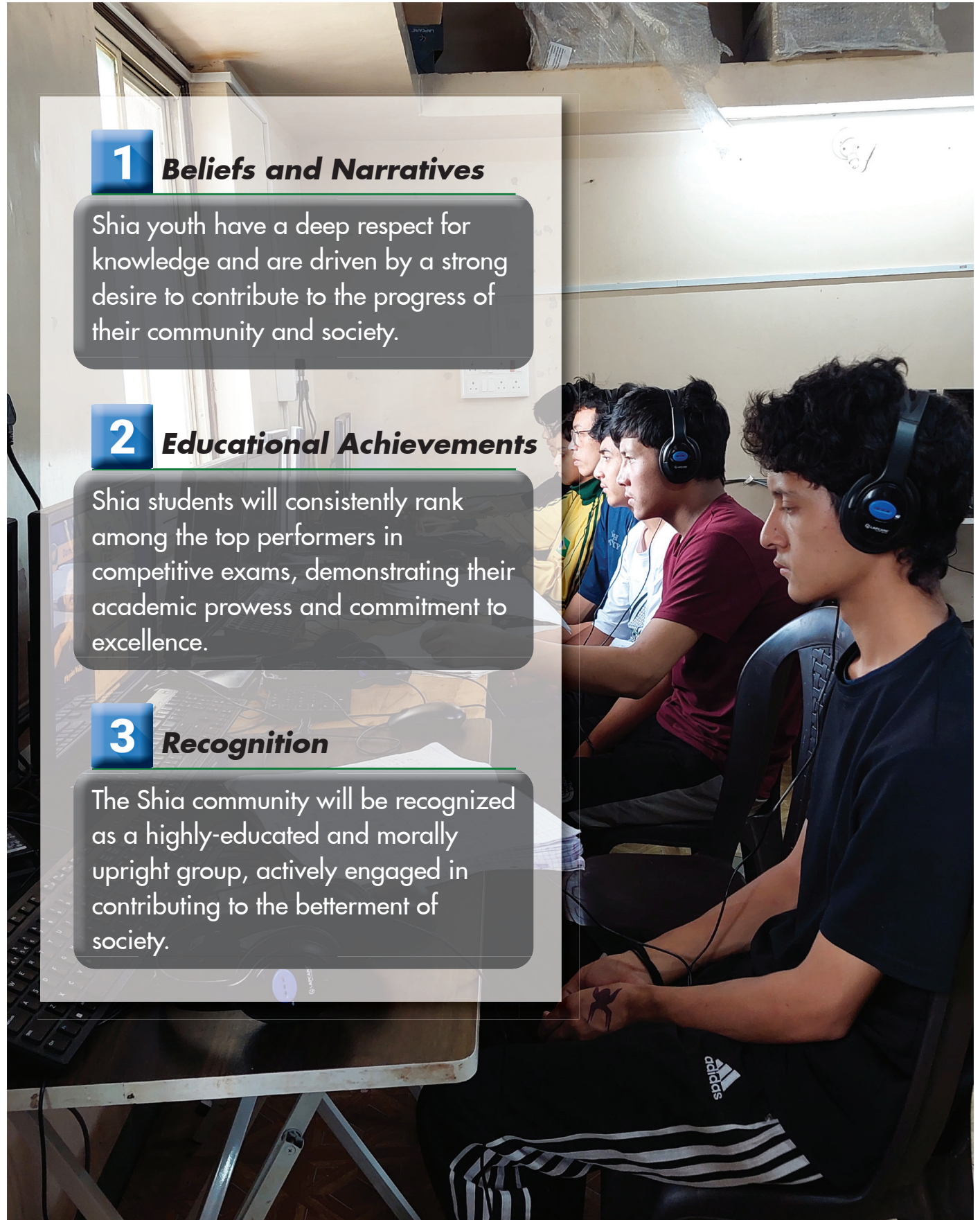
Shia youth have a deep respect for knowledge and are driven by a strong desire to contribute to the progress of their community and society.

### MANAGER

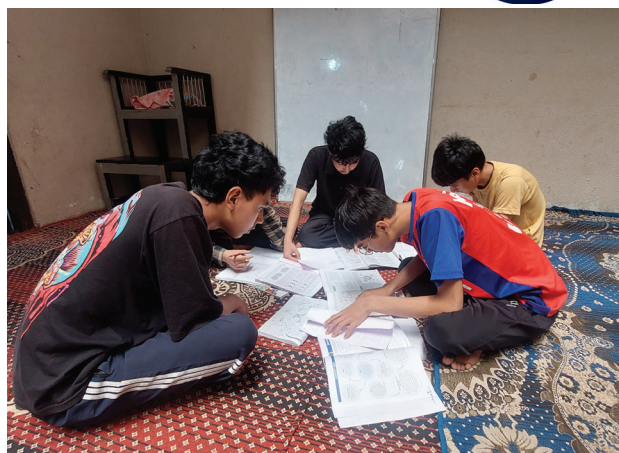




## WEEKLY & DAILY SCHEDULE

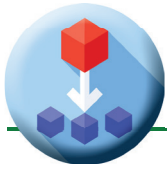

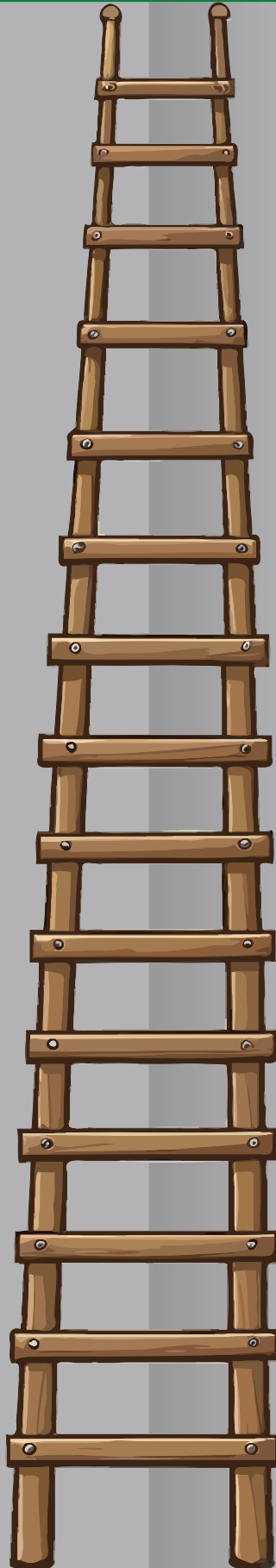

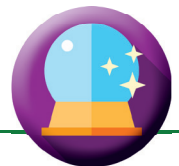
