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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Ladakh, a Himalayan region characterized by towering mountain passes and rugged valleys, experiences isolation for a significant portion of the year, typically 4 to 5 months, due to its remote location and challenging terrain. Despite its stunning natural beauty, the area faces educational challenges, particularly for students from remote areas and the Muslim community.

The impact of COVID-19 has further exacerbated these difficulties. The students belonging to border areas of Ladakh are majorly impacted. Limited access to resources due to the region's remoteness hampers the quality of education available. As a result, many students are compelled to leave Ladakh for their senior secondary and higher education.

Established in 1982, Imamiya Mission School has been dedicated to providing quality modern education grounded in moral values. Initially founded as a day boarding school, we have evolved into a residential cum day boarding institution, currently educating 400 students. Our hostel, designed with a capacity for 100 students, currently accommodates 30 students from far flung areas of Ladakh. Renowned for our academic excellence, we have consistently ranked among the top 10 schools in Ladakh under the Jammu and Kashmir Board. In 2022, we achieved another milestone by becoming affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).

Operating in a region marked by its remote nature and extreme climate, with temperatures plummeting as low as minus 20 degrees Celsius, we have invested in passive solar buildings for our hostels, ensuring warmth and comfort even during the harshest winters. While we currently offer education up to the 10th grade, we are proud to announce our expansion plans to include higher secondary education starting in 2025. Beyond academics, our students actively engage in sports, participate in science congresses, and compete in national-level competitions, showcasing their diverse talents and abilities.
